2019 Abbotsford Airshow & Pacific Northwest Adventure <u>August 8th thru 11th, 2019</u>



On Thursday afternoon, August 8th, PBS'ers will arrive in Bremerton, Washington (KPWT) to begin a long weekend in the Pacific Northwest. A PBS Hospitality area with snacks and liquid refreshments will await you on your arrival at the Airport. Beginning at 5:30PM that evening we will enjoy a Welcome Banquet at the Best Western Plus (BWP) (Silverdale Beach Hotel) located on beautiful Dyes Inlet of Puget Sound, complete with live music by the Lester Crow Band. Time to catch up with old friends and make some new ones.

Friday at 7:30AM we'll meet at BWP to tune up our eAPIS flight plan information. Canadian border crossing is very easy.



At 8:45AM on Friday we'll board the PBS Shuttle Vans and catch (walk on) the 9:50AM Washington State Ferry headed to the Seattle Waterfront. Upon arrival in Seattle we will head to Pier 57 to fly



Wings over Washington. Following our aerial tour of Washington we will board an Argosy Cruise boat at 1:30PM

on Pier 56 for a 45 minute boat ride to Tillicum Village on historic Blake Island. Once on Blake Island we will enjoy a traditionally prepared fire-roasted salmon BBQ and Northwest Native American storytelling show with 3D visual elements. After the dinner and show, another 45 minute Boat Cruise, and a 60 minute WSF Ferry trip will find us back across the Puget Sound on the Kitsap Peninsula,

The PBS Shuttle Vans will pick you up at 7:45AM on Saturday headed to the Bremerton Airport. We'll put "N" on the compass and fly to scenic Abbotsford, British Columbia, a flight of approximately 45 minutes. Upon arrival in Abbotsford we will be greeted by members of the Abbotsford Flying Club, and marshaled to parking on the runway designated for VIP arrivals. After securing our airplanes we'll walk to the Presidents Club, an executive seating and dining area on the Flightline (Country Club attire please). Meals and beverages are all included. Among other performers at Abbotsford this year, the US Air Force Thunderbirds Demonstration Team and the Canadian Forces Snowbirds will be performing. When the Airshow is over (approximately 5:15 PM) we'll fly to Bellingham, Washington (KBLI) to clear Customs. The US Customs folks at Bellingham are always professional and accommodating. When we arrive back at the Bremerton Airport we will enjoy dinner at the Airport Diner before our trip back to our waterfront lodging.

On <u>Sunday morning</u> be sure to sleep in and then have a leisurely breakfast. The PBS Shuttle Vans will head back to the Airport when you're rested and ready.
